NSW Fair Trading reminder - new scheme starts 1 January 2018



In the latest NSW Fair Trading update, we are reminded that the new strata building bond and inspections scheme is due to start on 1 January 2018. If you recall in the last edition of Around the Grounds we advised on the new online portal that accompanies this scheme.

As a refresher, Fair Trading tells us that "under the new scheme, developers of new residential and mixed-use high-rise strata developments, which are four storeys or higher, will be required to lodge a building bond with NSW Fair Trading. The amount secured by a building bond is to be 2% of the contract price for the building work."

Strata managers and indeed owners will be pleased to know that any defective building work identified between 15 and 18 months but not rectified by the builder before the end of 24 months may be rectified using an amount secured by the building bond.

In the user guide we state "the corporate member may make amendments to the template agency agreement, by hand alterations or by attached special conditions, to reflect terms agreed with specific clients.
